Multiplier Event 3D-ReMath

Successful Completion of the International Conference "Overcoming mathematical learning difficulties

using technology and ecology "
in the context of Erasmus+ Program:

"3D printing technology aims students understanding maths and recycling procedure" (3D-ReMath)

On Thursday, September 30, 2021, was held the International Conference, entitled: "Overcoming mathematical learning difficulties using technology and ecology", in hybrid form (combination of physical and electronic presence), with parallel activities in Greece, Italy and Portugal.

The Conference was attended by students, teachers, parents and guardians, researchers, academics, and the general public. In the context of the Conference, was highlighted the importance of the use of 3D printing and recycling in the educational process, in order for students to understand difficult mathematical concepts.

The educational activities, their impact and the results of the 3D-ReMath Project were also presented, documenting the contribution of STEM philosophy to education.

Special mention was made of the efficiency of transnational cooperation and synergy of the different levels of education. Both those directly involved in the project, teachers, students and academics, and those indirectly involved, such as representatives of institutional Europeans (eg Representative of the European Commission Department responsible for European Union policy in the fields of education, culture, youth , languages and sports), national (eg President of the Institute for Educational Policy), but also local agencies (eg local authorities of three collaborating areas, Regional Director of Primary and Secondary North Aegean), contributed to the multiplier benefits emphasizing the need not only to maintain, but also to expand them, at the level of object, but also scope.
